## Halloween Safety Tips

Halloween is a fun time for everyone, adults and kids alike. While the costumes and candy are on most kids' minds, it is important to focus some time on safety before they go out trick-or-treating. Follow these tips to help ensure a fun and safe Halloween for all!

- Children under the age of 12 should be accompanied by adult when trick-or-treating.
- Children who are mature enough to go out on their own should be reminded to stick to familiar, well-lit areas, and trick-or-treat in groups.
- Choose costumes that are bright in color, or add reflective tape or stickers.
- Carrying glow sticks or flashlights can help children see and be seen by drivers.
- Make sure to cross streets at crosswalks, and be sure to look left, right, and then left again when crossing.
- Stay on sidewalks or paths. If there are none, it is best to walk facing traffic, and stay as far to the left as possible.
- For drivers, it is important to drive slowly on Halloween night, especially in neighborhoods. Take extra time at intersections and be extra careful when backing up or entering and exiting driveways.
- Be alert! Put electronic devices away and make sure to know your surroundings!

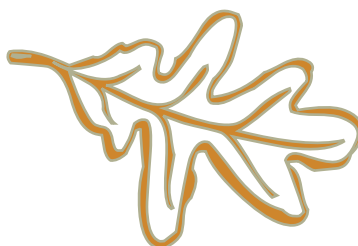
## Martial Arts with Kokoro Kai

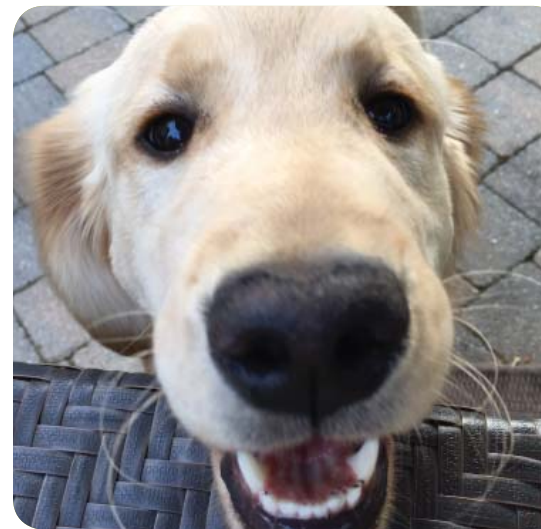

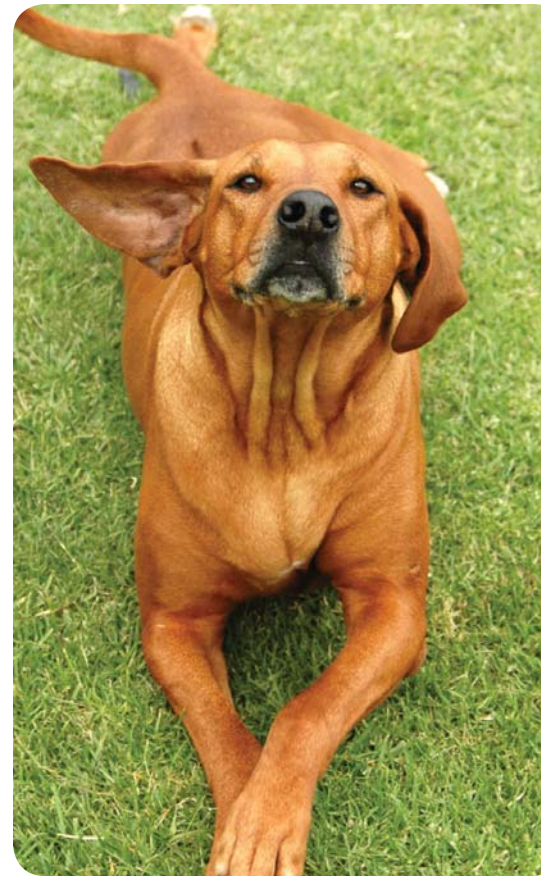
